

## Suggested Gear List

- Camo clothing – No bibs. Layering is good.
- We highly recommend wool – it stays warm, even when wet. No orange!
- Good, warm gloves, two pair if possible.
- Rain gear – NO Gortex, it's extremely loud. We recommend Helly Hansen ( Specifically: Impertech Reinforced Waist Pant and Gale Rain Jacket – can be found at [www.hhworkwear.com](http://www.hhworkwear.com)).
- Gaiters – NO SITKA, they are too loud. We prefer Kuiu, but Kenetrek will also work.
- Binoculars, range finder, etc. Guides do have these things, but most people find it nice to have their own.
- We do not provide shooting sticks. If you need them, please bring your own.
- Small flashlight or headlight.
- Good, comfortable hiking boots, water-proof is best. Uninsulated for May/June & September hunts, insulated for October-March hunts.
- Day pack – big enough for water, your lunch, gloves, extra socks, binoculars, etc.
- Sleeping bags are provided at camp, but during September/October/November hunts please bring your own sleeping bag in case we leave camp for a night or two and spike camp.
- We do not have a generator or phone chargers at camp. If you will need to charge any devices, please make sure you have a battery pack or solar charger.
